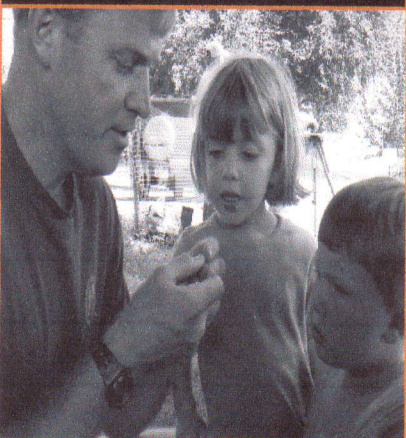

Neither do we. So we're excavating an historic archaeological site to learn more about those good old days when Elliot Park was on the edge of town.

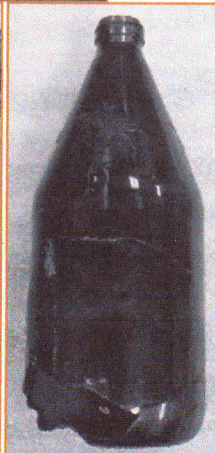
